

# GLOSSARY

**Agree:** To have the same opinion as someone else.

**Appointment:** A formal arrangement to meet someone at a specific time.

**Bad news:** Information about something sad, difficult, or negative.

**Beverages:** Any type of drink, such as water, juice, or coffee.

**Breakfast:** The first meal of the day, usually eaten in the morning.

**City attraction:** An interesting place that tourists like to visit in a city.

**Conversation:** A talk between two or more people where they share ideas.

**Dinner:** The main meal of the day, usually eaten in the evening.

**Disagree:** To have a different opinion from someone else.

**Future:** The time that is going to happen after now.

**Healthy:** Something that is good for your body and helps you stay well.

**Hobbies:** Activities that you enjoy doing in your free time.

**Holidays:** Special days of celebration (like Christmas) or a period of time away from home.

**Invitation:** A request to someone asking them to go somewhere or do something.

**Lunch:** A meal eaten in the middle of the day.

**Meals:** The occasions when you eat food (like breakfast, lunch, or dinner).

**Neighborhood:** The area where you live and the people who live near you.

**Past:** The time that has already happened.

**Plan:** A set of decisions about how to do something in the future.

**Routine:** A regular way of doing things in a specific order.

**Seasons:** The four parts of the year (spring, summer, autumn, and winter).

**Tourism:** The business of providing services for people who are traveling for fun.

**Vacation:** A period of time when you do not go to work or school to rest or travel.

**Weather:** The state of the air outside (like sun, rain, or snow).
