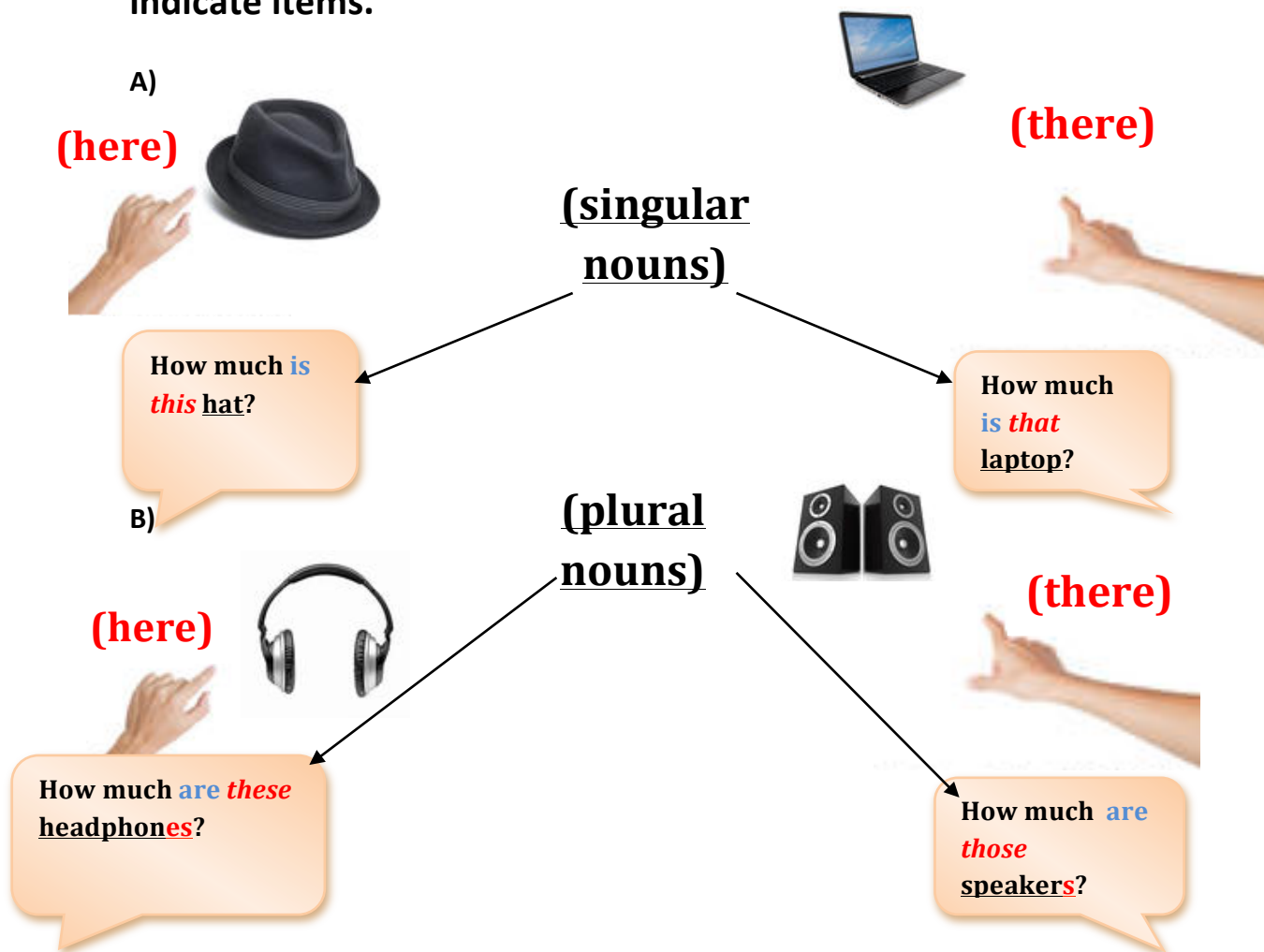


Demonstrative Pronouns

Look at the way the customer uses the words **this**, **these**, **that**, and **those** to indicate items.



Explanation:

- In part A the words **this** (near) and **that** (not near) indicate where a **singular** item is. e.g. *hat, laptop*
- In part B the words **these** (near) and **those** (not near) indicate where a **plural** item is. e.g. *headphones, speakers*
- **This, that, these, and those** are called demonstrative pronouns.
