
Demostrative Pronouns

Look at the way the customer uses the words *this*, *these*, *that*, and *those* to indicate items.



Explanation:

- In part A the words this (near) and that (not near) indicate where a singular item is. e.g. hat, laptop
- In part B the words *these* (near) and *those* (not near) indicate where a plural item is. *e.g.* headphones, speakers
- This, that, these, and those are called demonstrative pronouns.
